On the 1st and 5th Sundays, the deacons designate a cause of a local ministry or one that we are connected to and supporting abroad.

On the 2nd and 4th Sundays of each month, our offering is designated for the General Fund. This money is not just for the operation of Baldwin Christian Reformed Church in Baldwin, but there are a number of ministries and organizations that we support with the members and churches of our denomination (Christian Reformed Church in North America (CRCNA or CRC)) and of our classis (a regional group of churches in the CRC) through ministry shares. A portion of the giving on these weeks supports kingdom work at home and around the world.

On the 3rd Sunday of each month, our offering is typically designated for Baldwin Christian School (BCS). With their primary facilities located across the highway from the church building and the use of our facilities for their high school classes, there is a longstanding relationship between the school and our church. Our church does not run the school or require its members to attend there. One of the historic values of the CRC, though, has been encouraging its member families to educate their children in Christian day schools.
